The Department of Education is providing additional funding to all schools to help them improve their provision of PE and Sport for the benefit of primary aged pupils so that they develop healthy lifestyles. During 2016/17 Fatfield Academy received £8975 from the PE Sustainability Funding.

2016/2017 funding was spent on the following:

- Swimming lessons and transport for years 4,5 and 6.
- Transportation to and from sporting events.
- League fees
- Purchase of equipment for active playtimes.
- Staff training to promote positive play and behaviour
- Subsidised after school sports participation
