



### Sport Premium Funding '18-'19

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2018-19, Fatfield Academy will receive a total of £17,720. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

At Fatfield Academy, the PE Premium funding will be used to:

Employ a full time sports apprentice to develop extra sporting activities before and after school and support PE lead during tournaments and competitions.
Embark on an Outdoor Play and Learning Primary Programme to improve the quality of play opportunities resulting in active playtime.
Further CPD for staff – dance and gymnastics based on staff audit. This will enable staff to develop their confidence to teach these areas of PE at a higher level.
A review of PE equipment for a phased replacement programme.
CPD for lunchtime staff to further develop skills to support active lunchtimes
To continue to participate in Citywide festivals and sporting competitions as part of the Biddick Sports Academy PE cluster group.
All sporting participation and achievements will be celebrated through school assembly and the sporting display board.

As a result, of our dedication to physical activity in 2017/2018, we have been awarded with the accreditation of BRONZE Standard in the School Games and SILVER Standard for the City of Sunderland Active Charter Award. In 2018/2019 our aim is to build on these successes. Our skipping team were crowned winners of the 2017/2018 Regional Skipping Festival.
