



Proposed spend for Sport Premium Funding 2021-2022

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2021-22, Fatfield Academy will receive a total of £17,670. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

We propose to use our funding as follows:

Continued CPD for PE lead and release days to monitor the teaching and learning of PE linked to scheme of work. £1000.00
Staff CPD for new members of staff to increase their skills and knowledge based on outcomes of PE monitoring. £1,000.00
Continue to develop active play and lunchtimes with Outdoor Play and Learning Primary Programme. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchase resources for physical outdoor play • Develop the role of play leaders to support active playtime. £1500.00
Preparation for OPAL award £1500.00
Transport for Coastal schools £2000.00
Forest schools to develop outdoor physical activity £2000.00
Subsidised residential outdoor visits £1000.00
To continue to participate in Citywide festivals and sporting competitions as part of the Biddick Sports Academy PE cluster group. Festivals and transport £2000.00
Playground marking to provide a basketball and netball court for competitive sport. £1600.00
Playground markings to KS1 to develop co-ordination and physical play. £3000.00
