2	The children should draw 3 tens and 4 ones to complete the number 47 The children should write the number 4 in the tens column The children should draw 2 more tens counters and 6 more one counters. The children should draw 3 tens and 5 more ones.
3	a) $20 + 6 = 26$ b) $30 + 0 = 30$ c) $0 + 9 = 9$
4	a) There are 9 tens and 4 ones. The number is 94 b) There are 7 tens and 5 ones. The number is 75
5	The children should say they agree with Dexter, because 1 ten and 11 ones is equal to 2 tens and 1 one.
